Know all men by these presents, that we the undersigned, have this day organized and associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of Oregon, a corporation to be known and entitled by the corporate name of "The Squaw Creek Irrigation Company"; that the term of its existence shall be ninety-nine years; and the enterprise and business pursuant to said corporation for which it is formed are: to construct, maintain and operate ditches or canals, flumes, reservoirs, distributing ditches and feeders for general irrigation purposes, and for the purpose of diverting water from the natural channels or beds of any stream or water course, or lakes within the County of Crook, State of Oregon, and to condemn or purchase rights of way for any such ditches, canals, flumes, reservoirs, distributing ditches and feeders for the same, and for the purpose of furnishing and supplying water to other persons for irrigating, domestic and household purposes and for all general uses and purposes, and to charge reasonable and lawful rates therefor; to maintain such rights, privileges and immunities in such manner as is now provided by law in regard to building, owning and maintaining ditches, flumes, canals, reservoirs and distributing ditches and feeders for the same; and to purchase or sell real and personal property, and own and hold the same by and in its corporate name; to buy, sell and own lands, rights and privileges belonging to the same in its corporate name. The office or principal place of business of said corporation to be at Prineville in said Crook County, State of Oregon.

The amount of the capital stock of this corporation is Three thousand Dollars and to consist of shares of Dollars each.
